Absentee Ballots are available at the Eagle Lake Town Office

The Presidential Primary Election is Tuesday, March 5, 2024.

A copy of the Election Ballots will be posted with this notice.

Voting will be at the Eagle Lake Town Office. Polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Voters can choose to cast an absentee ballot instead of voting in person. Absentee ballots can be requested in writing, by phone or in person.

The deadline for requesting an absentee ballot is 4:30 P.M. on the Thursday prior to the election. (February 29, 2024)

If you are requesting a ballot by mail, please allow for postal delivery time.

You can request an absentee ballot by phone by calling the Eagle Lake Town Office at 444-5511.

All absentee ballots must be returned to the Eagle Lake Municipal Clerk no later than 8:00 p.m. March 5, 2024. (Election Day)
