is intending to file an application with the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) on or about

September 29, 2022 pursuant to the provisions of 38 MRSA, Section 1301 et seq. and Maine's Solid  
Waste Management Regulations.

The application is for bringing the Operations License for the transfer station located at 135 Convent Road in  
Eagle Lake up to date with the current operations at the transfer station.

According to Department regulations, interested parties must be publicly notified, written comments invited,  
and if justified, an opportunity for public hearing given. A request for a public hearing or for the Board of  
Environmental Protection to assume jurisdiction over this application, must be received by the Department, in  
writing, no later than 20 days after the application is accepted by the Department as complete for processing.

The application and supporting documentation are available for review at the Bureau of Remediation and Waste  
Management (BRWM) at the appropriate DEP regional office, during normal working hours. A copy of the  
application and supporting documentation may also be seen at the municipal office in Eagle Lake, Maine.
